



invite yourself to perform an Act of Random Kindness – ARK Day

Objective: Opportunity for students to **invite** themselves to perform a random act of kindness, or start a conversation with someone that they would not typically be put into conversation with. This activity is a great way to start a conversation with students about how to use the be nice. Action Plan face to face. Sometimes it's hard to think of ways to **invite** yourself to start a conversation with someone whom you've **noticed** needs a friend.

Instructions:

1. Discuss as a be nice. Chapter the importance of this activity.
 - a. What are they **noticing** about how fellow students reach out and talk to others that might be outside of their friend group – someone that they might not know?
2. Watch the Grandville HS example of ARK Day on the be nice.org Portal.
3. How could this activity be run at your school?
 - a. Pass out ARK slips as students walk in to the building at the beginning of the day.
 - b. Is it possible to have incentives/a photo competition students sharing pictures of them completing the ARK?
4. Brainstorm simple actions to show others you **notice** them.
 - a. Holding a door, greeting people in the morning or starting a conversation with a new person.
 - b. Type those ARKs (it's okay to repeat!) and cut them out before the activity date.
 - c. Pass out one slip to each student in the building.
 - d. Discuss the activity on the announcements.

****Remember to let staff know when the activity is happening so that they can be on board and promote.**

5. Make sure to make this a be nice. event. Have staff and your group wear their shirts, use the logo on posters, and use the Action Plan steps in your questions. Use this as a way to promote the second step of the Action Plan, **invite**.
6. Make sure every member of the group is assigned a few acts that they will perform throughout the day.
7. Ask participants and witnesses to think about how **inviting** yourself to act kindly can positively impact someone's whole day.
