



Getting to know you better

OPTIMAL GRADES: 6-12 Grades

be nice. ACTION PLAN focus: notice and invite

MATERIALS: none

DIRECTIONS:

Randomly assign students to pair off with another student. Have each student ask the other person 5 questions to get to know the other person better.

Some examples of questions:

- "If you could be famous, what would it be for?"
- "What is the one place you would want to visit and why?"
- "What is the most fun you have ever had?"
- "If you had 1 million dollars what would the first thing you would buy?"
- "If you could be born in a different era when would it be, and why?"

You can write the questions on the board or pass out papers with the questions already listed.

You can have students share one of their partner's responses to the whole class or you could split them in small groups to share or just leave them in pairs the whole time. This activity will help the students notice similarities and differences in one another.
